Title Position: Grounds Maintenance Team

Purpose of role: To keep our 2½ acres of gardens looking tidy and welcoming, for the benefit of our visitors and the local community.

Sample activities:

1. Grass-cutting and strimming around trees, maintaining pathways, hedge-trimming
2. Planting up new areas, clearing dead foliage and pruning trees
3. Planning input into and maintaining the community allotment area
4. Be part of the decision making process in planning future work in the garden
5. Ensure we have adequate supplies of tools and equipment to service the garden
